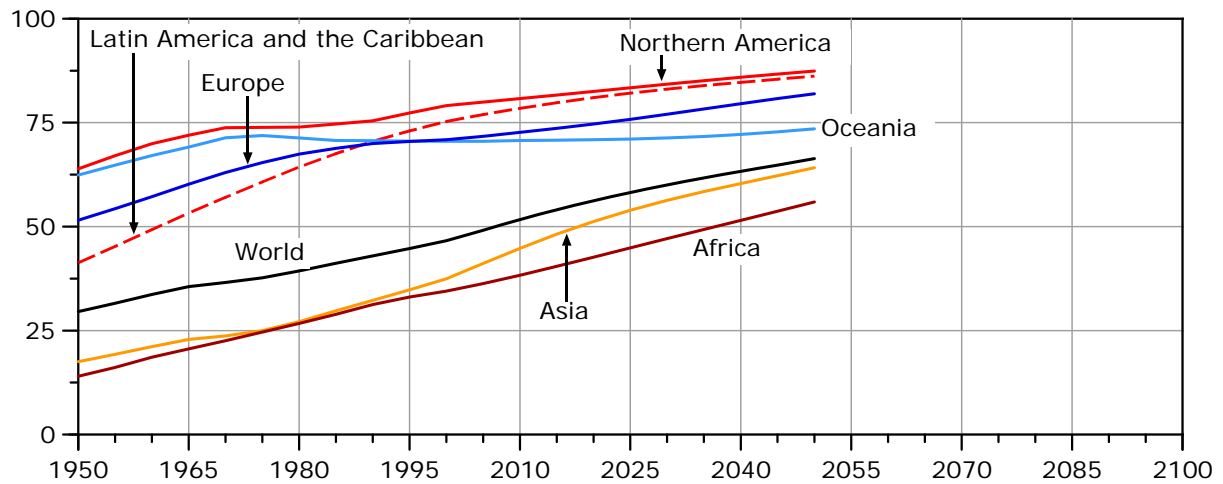
Total dependency ratio (ratio of population aged <20 and >64 per 100 aged 20-64)



Urban growth rate in %



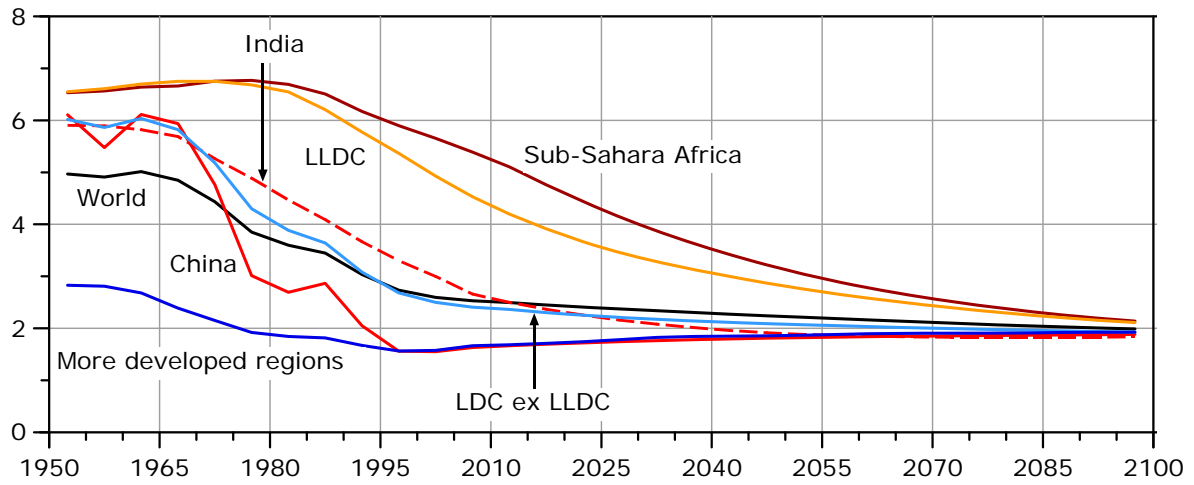

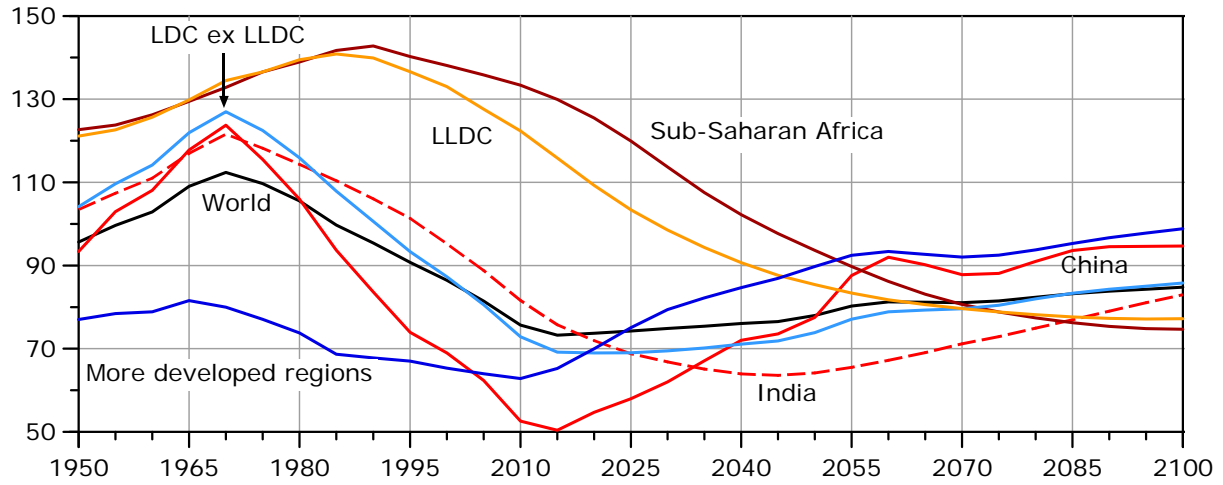

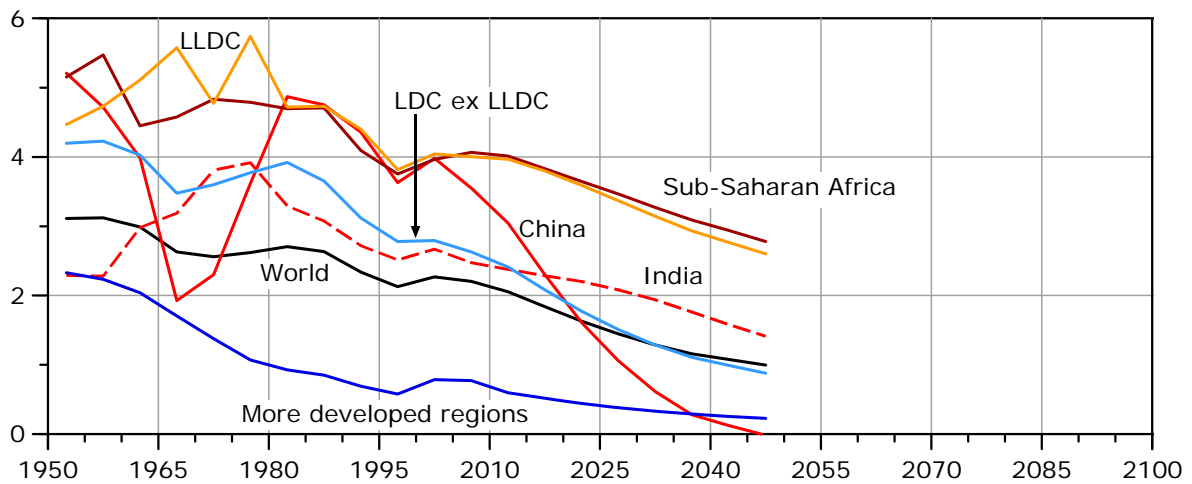
